PROJECT OVERVIEW

It is proposed to create a visual barrier along northbound SR 99, to provide a more visually appealing entrance to City of Modesto, as drivers approach the City from the South and prior to crossing the scenic Tuolumne River. Caltrans had removed a row of eucalyptus trees obscuring the rather large wrecking yard in 2018 within the project limits, but which were a safety hazard in the freeway clear recovering zone. The view of the wrecking yard and mobile park creates a rather unsightly view and has existing walls have been plastered with unsightly graffiti. The proposed visual barier will be coordinated with anticipated local grant project that is also proposing to install visual barrier at other entry points to the area. A visual barrier may not only only cover up blight, but could be enhanced to provide visually stimulating views.
